



### **Fremont Township Brush Removal Policy**

- Due to increased requests for brush pick up and limited resources, the Fremont Township Highway Department will be making the following changes to its Brush Removal policy effective 9/17/2018. ***The Township will no longer offer “anytime” brush removal and chipping to township residents.*** When a township resident hires a tree service or landscaper to; cut down trees, trim bushes or clear a vacant lot, it is the responsibility of the service provider to remove the brush.

To meet your brush removal needs:

- **Subdivision Approved Pick-up:** Fremont Township Highway Department will work with the Homeowners Associations to coordinate brush pickup dates.
- **Weather Related Incidents:** The Highway Department will continue to deploy staff after these incidents to remove any brush that is brought to the right of way providing the road is maintained by the Fremont Township Highway Department. If you are unsure who maintains your right of way, please call the highway office at 847.223.2848.
- **Unincorporated township residents:** that reside on township maintained roads that do not fall within a subdivision should notify the Highway Department before any pruning or trimming occurs to see if a brush pickup can be arranged. These residents will be limited to (2) non-weather-related pickups per calendar year.



### **Brush Pile Guidelines**

- Brush piles need to be adjacent to the street whenever possible with all the cut ends facing the same direction. Please keep brush piles off the street.
- Keep all brush piles free from grass clippings, plant vegetation, rocks, dirt, wire, lumber and steel.
- Please leave tree limbs as long as possible.
