

# Fremont Township Parks Committee

## Meeting Minutes – June 11, 2014

**1. Call to order**

Trustee Martin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**8. Project Report:**

Herb Reidel reported on the following:

**Behm Park**

Construction of the storage maintenance building at Behm is complete. Electrical work is completed and the well installation is also completed. The crew had to dig to a depth of 296 feet, deeper than originally anticipated, and a 3 horse power pump was installed.

Have received quotes for electrical work and plans will be sent to plumbers to get quotes for the new restrooms.

All plans for the restrooms have been submitted to the County and we are waiting for the permit.

The irrigation pond has been repaired. Herb Reidel stated he would like to install an aerator to help with weed control. Trustee Martin suggested he contact McCloud Aquatic Services to have the pond treated.

### **Ivanhoe Park**

The installation of an electronic gate has been completed. The fire department installed a Knox Box to gain entrance to the park.

The dugout is completed, but needs to be painted.

A permit has been obtained for the new storage shed. The user groups are working on completing the shed.

Some ball field lights are not working. Herb is evaluating and will meet with a contractor to fix the problem.

Discussed and reviewed plans for paving the parking lot at Ivanhoe Park, including the addition of approximately 25 parking spaces.

### **General**

Signs stating "Park at Your Own Risk" have been posted at both parks.

We have received waivers from the soccer groups.

New signage for the entrance at all township facilities was discussed. It was suggested that the font be changed.
