The first Public Hearing on Revenue Sharing Funds was called to order by Chairman, George Bill. A legal notice was published in the Independent-Register and the Fremont Patriot on March 19, 1980 informing the Fremont Township citizens may provide written and oral comments and requests for allocations of Federal Revenue Sharing monies.

Mr. Bill stated that the Revenue Sharing Budget for <sup>the</sup> fiscal year is 56,000.<sup>00</sup>. Mr. Bill further explained that all allocations will be considered up to September since there has been no confirmation that the Federal Revenue Sharing program will be continued beyond that time. Mr. Bill also stated that of the 56,000.<sup>00</sup> there are three committed allocations carried forward from last years budget. They are \$30,000.<sup>00</sup> for the Sheriff's patrol; \$1,000.<sup>00</sup> for the Lake County Museum (building material); and \$150.<sup>00</sup> for the Lions Club (special materials for the blind and hearing impaired).

The following requests were received:

1. Chain of Lakes Senior Services represented by Ruth Davidson. \$370.<sup>00</sup> for transportation. This program has served 11 Fremont residents.
2. Fremont Sup. Library represented by Leonard Schmitt, Pres. \$3,465.<sup>00</sup> - burglar alarm; \$1,700.<sup>00</sup> for

Fire alarm; \$2,135.<sup>00</sup> - historical paper storage (microfilm) Total request \$6,300.<sup>00</sup> or any portion thereof.

3. Mundelein Lions Club represented by Mrs. Stanley Rouse. \$1,000.<sup>00</sup> for enlarging and improving the reading aids for the blind and hearing impaired.

4. Lake County Museum represented by Gary J. Keller. \$1,000.<sup>00</sup> was requested for an item or items that Mr. Keller will submit at the April 8th. Second public hearing.

5. Countryside Fire Dist represented by Captain Lewis Landry. \$2,000.<sup>00</sup> toward the purchase of a video playback recorder for the training education of fireman. The unit would be portable and would be used in conjunction with other fire districts.
