### 7. NEW BUSINESS

#### 7.1 2019 Paratransit Transportation Funding Agreement

- Trustee Shanahan moved, and Trustee Voss seconded the motion to approve the 2019 Paratransit Funding Agreement with Lake County. All in favor, motion carried.

#### Discussion

Supervisor O'Kelly explained the township pays \$4000.00 to provide service for residents on Ride Lake County West and \$150.00 for Ride Lake County Central. If in the future, if more townships elect to participate in the ride share programs, the cost to Fremont Township will decrease.

#### 7.2 Policy for Clerk to Attest Supervisor's Signature on Check Payments

Discussion

Clerk McCann reviewed the proposed Policy and assured the Board that measures have consistently been in place to monitor the Supervisor's payment of bills. Those measures will continue and will meet the State's mandate to attest the Supervisor's signature on all payouts.

### **7.3 Determine Amounts for 2018 Town and Road Levy's**

- Township Staff installed new Backstop for Multi-Purpose Field. Will work with both the Lightning and the Stallions to determine how much sideline fence is needed.
- Alicia and Herb met with a Culligan Water representative to discuss the costs to install a reverse osmosis system at Behm to create a better-quality drinking water. A follow up discussion with pricing and water test analysis will happen at the January Parks meeting.
- Irrigations systems are scheduled to be winterized this week
- Pickleball court windscreens and nets will remain up if weather allows. Daytime highs in the 50's still allow for decent playing conditions
- Restrooms will remain open if pickleball courts are open for play

**3. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

**4. LEVY AND BUDGET DISCUSSION**

The following items were discussed for consideration in the Town FY 2019/2020 Budget:

General Town Administration Center

- Widening & Repaving of Admin parking lots and access road. Propose to budget \$100,000. for this project
- Security system & keyless door entry system. Mr. Riedel will explore options for security features.

General Town Administration Center Maintenance

- Replacement of (2) fire access doors. Propose to budget \$10,000 for replacement due to extreme rust and improper door function.
- Replacement of fire-safe file cabinets in Clerk’s office.

Parks Maintenance

- Crack Sealing of Behm Parking Lot, Walking Paths & Ivanhoe Parking Lot - Propose to budget \$19,000. at \$.50/ ft. = 38,000 ft of crack sealing.
- Ivanhoe Ballfield Light Maintenance - Propose to budget \$5,000. to cover bulbs, ballasts and aerial equipment rental for (4) ballfield lights that are not working.
- Native Plantings - Propose to budget \$5,000. to cover seed and supplies for areas being considered for Native Habitat.



Behm Park Development

- Paving of Limestone walking paths at Behm Park - Propose to budget \$19,000-\$75,000, depending on which pathways are paved
- Sideline fencing for Multi-Purpose field - Propose to budget **\$15,000** for installation of chain link fencing. Township staff would auger, set and concrete posts. Township would hire professional contractor to stretch and install mesh fencing.

Ivanhoe Park Development

- Ivanhoe Dugout Rebuild - Propose to budget **\$15,000** for modifications to dugout fencing. Township staff would remove existing fencing, likely rebuild post structure and have professional contractor stretch and install new mesh.

Road District Budget ConsiderationsAge of vehicles & equipment

- (4) Vehicles that are still from the 90's. These vehicles are becoming more expensive and harder to maintain.
- Plan is to have (3) of these vehicles replaced by 2023
- Will try to implement a 15-20-year rotation

Age of main office, mechanics bay and storage garage

- Main office is from the late 70's, mechanics bay and storage garage from late 60's
- Roof, exterior wall panels, windows and insulation are areas of concern
- Roof coating was applied to mechanics bay and storage garage in 2017 to allow a 10-year savings plan to be implemented for a new roof structure. New shingles were applied to office area in 2017 as well.
- New floor drains, new A/C unit if office area, (2) new service doors and (2) new garage doors installed in 2018.
- New bright white interior paint and LED lighting for storage garage planned for 2019 season

Implementing a 15-year Paving Cycle

- **2017:** Countryside Highlands, Sylvan Lake Dam, Grove, Oak Ave (east), Elmwood to Maple, Maple to Speed Hump
- **2018:** Schwerman Road, Pheasant Run, Bittersweet Trail, Countryside Lake Sub. (Countryside Lake Drive, Red Pine Ct., Jack Pine Ct., Driftwood Ct., Lakeview Pkwy (Beach), Maple Rd (Beach), Sunset & Ridge Ct.
- **2019:** Lakeview Parkway west of Chevy Chase, Oakleaf Court, Thorntree Rd, Beechwood Ct., Countryside Valley Dr., Lakeview Parkway (From Countryside Valley Dr. to York Lane), Hickory Road, Erhart Road (Fremont Center to Gilmer), Hickory Ave West (Diamond Lake), Chardon Rd (at the expense of CLCJAWA)
- **2020:** Steeple Chase Subdivision, S. Sylvan Dr., Circle Dr., University Dr., Kenwood Ct., Oakdale Ln., Hillside Ln
- **2021:** West Shore Dr., Pierre Dr., Martin Dr., Iride Dr., Hawthorn Blvd, Trinity Dr.
- **2022:** Fairview Dr., Lake Tr., Forest Ln. South, West Prospect Dr.

Salt quantities, usage and damage to equipment

- Amount needed dependent on weather conditions
- Try to use products that are safer for the environment, cost of product is more but will hopefully help the environment and also help our equipment.
- Township is required by the IEPA to keep track of our salt and liquid totals. Have installed computer systems in trucks to help us track usage.


