**TAX LEVY ORDINANCE**

**FREMONT ROAD DISTRICT**

**ORDINANCE No. 273**

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for **Fremont Township Road District**, Lake County, Illinois, for the tax year 2018, collectable in 2019.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Trustees of Fremont Township, Lake County, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the Highway Commissioner of Fremont Township Road District on December 10, 2018 does hereby determine and declare that the sum of **One Million Six Hundred Twenty Six Thousand, One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$1,626,180.00)** are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Fremont Township Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

**Road & Bridge Fund**  
**Permanent Road Fund**

for the year 2018.

**SECTION 4:** That the Board of Trustees does hereby certify that the amount levied herein is necessary to be raised by taxation for road purposes for the Fremont Township Road District.

**SECTION 5:** That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.


**SECTION 6:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.

**CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE  
TRUTH IN TAXATION  
ROAD DISTRICT LEVY**

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Fremont Township Road District, and as such presiding officer I certify that the 2018 Levy Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Sections 18-60 through 18-85 of the "TRUTH in TAXATION" law.
