4. REFUSE HAULING DISCUSSION

- Walter Willis from SWALCO reviewed options to include and/or exclude from single hauler RFP. Township administrative duties include preparing RFP, legal review, evaluating bid submissions, and if so determined to proceed, obtaining performance bond and execution of single hauler contract.
- Contract will be negotiated for residential services only.
- Supervisor O’Kelly stated the goal of the township is to acquire improved waste/recycling hauling services for residents at a lower price than most currently pay.
- Willis/SWALCO will begin writing RFP and will work with Supervisor O’Kelly to obtain information required for vendors to quote leaf vac services for specific neighborhoods, contact information for owners of local mobile home parks, size of receptacles at townhomes/condos and size, number and location of township receptacles to be included in RFP.

5. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- If township contracts with a single hauler, depending on date of execution, if service period overlaps, residents may have to contact their previous hauler to request refunds.
- New waste hauler will notify residents when service will begin and produce an educational brochure referring to hauler services, recycling do’s and don’ts, etc.
- New hauler will bill residents direct.
- Community representatives will be notified of the date and time for the next discussion forum.
