HIGHWAY PERMIT BOND POLICIES

1. A \$ 2,500.00 cash bond is required before work is started.
2. Apply for and obtain a Driveway Approach Permit and a Highway Bond Permit from the Highway Commissioner, Alicia Dodd at 847 – 223 – 2848 prior to starting any work.
3. Size and length of culvert pipe if required will be determined by the Highway Commissioner. Culvert pipe will be purchased and installed by the homeowner/contractor per the Highway Commissioner's specifications.
4. Storage of materials on roadway or within right of way is strictly prohibited. Doing so will forfeit the entire road bond.
5. Edge of the road and right-of-way must be built up before moving in heavy equipment.
6. Six-ton load limit per axle will be enforced, unless specified by the Highway Commissioner.
7. Mud and Debris on road or right-of-way must be cleaned up and removed from the right-of-way daily as per Chapter 121, Illinois Revised Statutes.
8. Road, shoulders, ditches and any other areas must be restored to its original condition.
9. Cement trucks are not to be cleaned or contents dumped onto the Township right-of-way.
10. If above policies are not followed or work is not completed satisfactorily, all or a portion of the bond may be used by The Highway Department to complete the said work.
11. Request for the return of bond money must be made within two years of the permit date or bond will be forfeited to The Highway Department. There will be no interest paid or fees charged on Highway Permit Bond.
